
The foundation aims to bridge the opportunity gap for Tanzanian youth by providing free or affordable access to training, mentorship, resources, and platforms that develop both talent and character. Our goal is to raise a generation of confident, skilled, and innovative young Tanzanians prepared to contribute to national development.



Tanzania has a youthful population, with over 65% below age 25. Although rich in talent and potential, many youths face:

- Limited access to digital and job-ready skills
- High unemployment rates
- Lack of mentorship and opportunities
- Limited creative arts training
- Minimal access to sports facilities & proper coaching
- Social challenges such as poverty, drug abuse, and idleness

Because of this, many young people struggle to reach their full potential. YSCEF intends to provide long-term solutions by empowering youth with skills, mentorship, and safe spaces to grow.



BACKGROUND

Equity in education is currently not completely equal, because it is not yet like in cities that have implemented an international standard education system that is able to compete with other countries. Education in remote areas is almost backward and some are even illiterate because the location of the school is very far from their settlements. We must accept and fix this educational gap for a better future.

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES



OBJECTIVES OF THE FOUNDATION

Main Objectives

1. Provide free or affordable training in ICT, digital skills, and entrepreneurship.
2. Support youth talents in music, dance, drawing, acting, and creative media.
3. Develop community sports programs to engage, inspire, and mentor young people.
4. Offer mentorship programs led by professionals and role models.
5. Promote community development, leadership, and personal discipline.

Specific Objectives

- Train 500+ youths annually in digital and creative skills.
- Establish at least 5 community youth clubs/sports teams.
- Provide scholarships for talented but vulnerable youth. (03)
- Build a Youth Resource & Innovation Hub.


Good education will have an impact on village economic development, so that villages can be more advanced because of the many educated human resources.



- Teachers' Room: 1 room (3 x 3 m)
- Sanitation Facilities: 2 rooms (1 x 1 m)
- Library: 1 room (3 x 3 m)
